STEVE HATHAWAY

Inducted October 3, 2013



Stompin' Steve Hathaway has hosted the weekly radio program, "The Cupertino Barndance," for over 35 years on KKUP, Cupertino, California. The program features classic country music (50's and 60's honky tonk, western swing, bluegrass, rockabilly, and an-

ything contemporary that fits). It airs 9 P.M. to Midnight, Sundays at 91.5 FM on the dial.

Stompin' Steve is an avid country music collector with an extensive library of books, records, photographs, 16mm films, and videos of country and jazz music. He has contributed to the liner notes and/or photos and received acknowledgements on numer-

ous western swing record reissues on such labels as Old Timey, Rambler, Rhino, Country Routes, Bear Family, and Franklin Mint.

Clips from his film collection including those of Bob Wills have been used in television documentaries

on PBS, A&E and TNN. Clips of his Cindy Walker films were used, at her request, for her induction into the Country Music Hall of Fame CMA Awards Show on CBS. He also contributed biographies for The Encyclopedia of Country Music (Oxford University Press) for Billy Hughes, Smokey Rogers, Billy Jack Wills, and Luke Wills.

He has tirelessly promoted western swing through his radio program, hosting many bands live on-air including Smith's Ranch Boys, The Saddle Cats, West Coast Ramblers, and the Lone Star Retrobates as well as interviews with Johnny Cuviello, Vance Terry, Tom Morrell, Bobby Black, Shorty Joe, Billy Mize, Bill Woods, Speedy West, Herb Remington and many more.

He was a major contributor to the Baylor University Texas Oral History Project. For many years he published the *Western Swing Newsletter*, aimed at record collectors and western swing music aficionados. His current website www.westernswing.com contin

John Girton

Inducted October 5, 2025



John Girton is well known throughout the world for his work as lead guitarist with the group "Dan Hicks and the Hot Licks." John recorded 3 albums with the group, and also wrote and arranged material for them. He was also featured as guitarist, saxophonist,

clarinetist, and occasional mandolinist with the popular vocalist, Maria Muldaur for many years.

After numerous international tours, John started his own group in the San Francisco area. This group, the "Girtones" played a blend of Jazz, Swing and Blues in Oregon and California, sometimes including singer Maria Muldaur as a member. John has made several solo tours of England, where he performed in concerts and clubs throughout the country. In recent years he has performed with such groups as "Backwoods Jazz", the "George Souza Band", and is quite active in the Nevada County Music scene.

He currently performs solo jazz guitar at various venues in the Foothills area of California and has recently released a new CD called "You Are There", which was produced at John's "Nugget Studios" in Grass Valley, CA. John has been playing music professionally for over 20 years as an instrumentalist, vocalist, recording artist, studio musician, and composer. His original songs are a mixture of jazz, swing, blues and folk music, with a bit of humor thrown in for good measure.


